	approved. For the <i>Rome</i> topic, it was agreed that the focus should be on three buildings
	that offer an historical aspect and an understanding of the individual associated with
	the building, and allows particular moments attached to that structure to be explored.
	There was agreement to focus on the stories and the people connected to the building.
	This focus needs a stronger presence in the introduction. Edits were suggested to the
	learning outcomes and approved. There was agreement that the CBA should focus on a
	building/structure that was not studied within the strand.
